Monday – Introduction & Pretest

Goal: Introduce the week’s words and assess prior knowledge.

- **Students:**
 - Review the weekly word list (spelling patterns, roots, prefixes/suffixes).
 - Complete a **Power Spelling pretest**.
 - Begin assigned introductory practice or games.
- **Teacher:**
 - Review pretest data to identify students who:
 - Need targeted support
 - Are ready for challenge or enrichment
 - Assign differentiated practice as needed.

Tuesday – Practice & Word Study

Goal: Reinforce spelling patterns and vocabulary meaning.

- **Students:**
 - Complete assigned Power Spelling practice activities.
 - Focus on:
 - Spelling accuracy
 - Word meaning and usage (for vocab courses)
- **Teacher:**
 - Confer with students or small groups.
 - Provide targeted feedback or clarification.

Wednesday – Apply & Build Accuracy

Goal: Strengthen retention and application.

- **Students:**
 - Continue practice through:
 - Games or study modes

- Sentence application or context-based practice (if applicable)
 - Replay activities to improve accuracy and performance.
 - **Teacher:**
 - Use midweek data to adjust assignments.
 - Pull intervention or enrichment groups as needed.
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Thursday – Review & Test Readiness

Goal: Prepare students for assessment.

- **Students:**
 - Complete:
 - Review activities
 - Practice tests or final study rounds
 - Focus on common errors identified earlier in the week.
 - **Teacher:**
 - Provide last-minute support or clarification.
 - Address patterns of misunderstanding.
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Friday – Assessment & Differentiation

Goal: Assess mastery and extend learning.

- **Students:**
 - Complete the **weekly Power Spelling test**.
 - After testing:
 - Students who need improvement complete targeted remediation.
 - Students who demonstrate mastery engage in enrichment or challenge activities.
 - **Teacher:**
 - Review assessment data.
 - Plan follow-up instruction or next week's focus.
