

★ Sample Weekly Power Spelling Schedule for 3–5 ★

Monday – Pretest + Power Spelling Games

Goal: Introduce the new word list and assess what students already know.

1. Pretest

- Students complete the Power Spelling pretest.
- This identifies words students already know and those that need review.

2. Assign Practice Based on Pretest

- Students who scored high may jump into enrichment games or vocabulary practice.
- Students needing support can be assigned targeted activities for their focus words.

3. Independent or Small-Group Game Time

- Students play Power Spelling games using their individualized word lists.
- Teacher meets with small groups or conducts reading conferences.

Tuesday – Spelling & Vocabulary Skill Games

Goal: Provide interactive practice and reinforce phonics patterns and meaning.

- Students work through **pattern-based games, vocabulary match, or sentence-building games.**
- Teacher continues to pull small groups for reading or skill instruction.
- Early finishers can replay games for score improvement or explore optional challenge games.

Wednesday – Practice, Apply, and Build Accuracy

Goal: Strengthen accuracy through repeated exposure and varied activity types.

- Students complete assigned **practice rounds, typing activities, or study modes.**
- Encourage students to track progress or try to increase their highest game score.
- Teacher uses this time for targeted intervention or enrichment groups.

Thursday – Review + Test Readiness

Goal: Final review before the Friday test.

- Students complete a **practice test**, additional games, or vocabulary review.
 - Use Power Spelling data to pull a **small booster group** for students who are still struggling.
 - Higher-achieving students can work on challenge lists or creative vocabulary tasks.

Friday – Spelling Test + Remediation or Free Play

Goal: Assess mastery and differentiate follow-up activities.

1. Weekly Spelling Test

- Students complete their Power Spelling test. Scores are recorded automatically.

2. Follow-Up Activities (Based on Score)

- **Students who score below mastery:**
 - Complete **remedial practice activities**, focusing on missed words.
 - Redo selected games or activities targeting mistakes.
- **Students who meet or exceed mastery:**
 - Participate in **free-choice Power Spelling games**, vocabulary challenges, or enrichment extensions.

This structure keeps **every student engaged**, even after the weekly test.
